

## 23,000 LETTERS OF SUPPORT FOR THE STIBNITE GOLD PROJECT!

Perpetua Resources' Stibnite Gold Project has received an unprecedented level of public support. During the 2020 and 2022 comment periods, approximately 85% of feedback was positive. By listening to our communities, Perpetua Resources has made the Stibnite Gold Project the best it can be.

## **Project Timeline:**

- 2010 Perpetua begins study, engineering and community engagement.
- 2016 NEPA review begins under joint review process.
- 2020 75-day Public Comment Period on the Draft Environmental Impact Statement.
- 2020 Perpetua proposes improvements based on 10,000 comments recieved.
- → 2022 75-day Public Comment Period on the Supplemental Draft Environmental Impact Statement, which closed with over 15,000 comments supporting the project.
- 2025 After 8 years in NEPA, the Stibnite Gold Project received its Final Record of Decision.





## **Listening Made It Better:**

- 13% reduction in project footprint over original design.
- 70% reduction in Hangar Flats Pit over original design.
- → 20+ miles of habitat opened for migrating fish.
- 96% reduction in arsenic in Meadow Creek (below Tailings Storage Facility) vs. existing conditions.
- 40% reduction in arsenic in EFSF Salmon River (below Sugar Creek) vs. existing conditions.
- 140% uplift in wetlands quality (wetland functional units).
- 63% net increase in wetland acres vs. existing conditions.
- 9.5% uplift in stream habitat quality (stream functional units).
- Water temperature reduced to be at, or below, existing conditions.
- ★ 60% reduction in mercury emissions over original project design to be less than 20% of applicable EPA standards.

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
