



The Stibnite Gold Project Fact Sheet

The Stibnite Gold Project will:

- ◆ Restore an abandoned mine site.
- ◆ Responsibly produce the minerals we need for national defense and clean energy.
- ◆ Provide family-wage jobs and infrastructure to rural Idaho.

Restoration: The Stibnite Gold Project is located on an abandoned mine site that is in desperate need of repair. Our Project will leave conditions better than they are today. The Project will clean up legacy tailings and waste, restore a river and reconnect fish migration to miles of spawning grounds that have been blocked for 80 years.

National Security: The Stibnite Gold Project will be the only domestically mined source of the critical mineral antimony we need for national defense. Antimony is used in munitions, night vision goggles and military uniforms. China, Russia, and Tajikistan control 90% of the world's supply of antimony. In late 2024, China restricted global antimony exports globally and to the U.S. The Stibnite Gold Project can securely and responsibly provide 35% of America's antimony demand in the first six years of operations and fulfill long-term U.S. defense needs.

Clean Energy: Antimony from the Stibnite Gold Project will help shape America's clean energy future. Perpetua Resources is partners with a battery manufacturer poised to play a key role in reducing carbon emissions. The antimony Perpetua has committed in its partnership will enable 1 million American homes to be powered with solar energy every day for 20 years.

Jobs: The Stibnite Gold Project will provide family-wage jobs for hundreds of hardworking Americans. During operations, we will bring 500-600 jobs to rural Idaho. We will provide onsite housing for our employees and schedule shifts to make our jobs accessible to as many families as possible.

Supply Chain Resiliency: Secure supply chains start at home. We are committed to operating at the highest environmental, social and ethical standards when we mine here. As demand grows for mined materials, we have choices to make on how we safeguard America's supply chains and strengthen our resiliency. Until we bring mining home, our supply chains remain vulnerable.

It's Time: After more than a decade of working to make the Project right for Idaho, it is moving forward. The Project has undergone eight years of rigorous interagency permitting and received more than 28,000 letters during 150 days of formal public comment, in which 85% of feedback supported the Project moving forward. By listening to our communities and working through the science-based permitting process, we believe we have made the Project the best it can be. From recreational access to improved water quality, we are proud of our solutions.

Community Partnerships: Perpetua Resources is proud to call Idaho and Valley County home. The Stibnite Gold Project is designed to invest in and benefit our neighbors and the surrounding communities. With all partnerships, we have committed to looking locally first where available.

In January 2025, the Stibnite Gold Project received its Final Record of Decision.
